I had looked from time to time for a 1939 Ford Coupe and finally found what I was looking for (I hoped!)

It was a black Deluxe that was advertised on Hemmings. There was only one picture in the ad but I made the call and the owner sent many more pictures and gave me a pretty good rundown on the car. I lucked out, the block and crank were both good. During the rebuild I had Offenhauser heads and an intake and dual carbs and an Isky Max1 cam installed.
